## Payment Policy

The total cost of your desired surgical procedure(s) is divided into 3 main components.

- Surgeon's Professional Fee (which includes all preoperative and postoperative care)
- Facility Fee (which includes implant and garment costs, if applicable)
- Anesthesia Fee
- Additional costs associated with laboratory tests and prescription medications may be involved.

*The fee quoted will remain in effect for sixty days from the consultation date unless otherwise noted herein. In order to schedule surgery, a \$500 deposit will be required. The remaining balance for surgical fees is payable in advance of surgery at the time of Preoperative Visit with Washington Plastic Surgery. Separate payments shall be made to Pacific Surgical Center for the facility cost and to the Anesthesia providers at the time of the Preoperative Visit with the Pacific Surgical Center. The deposit is refundable within three business days from the date of issuance. In the event that the patient cancels the procedure(s) without a verifiable, legitimate medical problem within a period of 2 weeks prior to surgery, the deposit will be retained by this practice. In the event a legitimate medical problem bars performance of the surgical procedure(s), the patient will receive a full refund of all payments received.*

*In general, the original payment does not cover for any costs associated with treatment/ care of postoperative complications or revisions which may require additional surgeries and/or hospitalizations. These costs are sole responsibilities of the patient. At all times, case by case determination will be made. Please feel free to inquire further about our policy.
